The West Bengal Pollution Control Board hereby grants its 'Consent to Operate' under section 25 & 26 of the water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Rules and Orders made thereunder to M/s Babul (A Family Restaurant) Prop. Pintu Barman for its unit located at Unit No - G.6A, Kogla Vihza, Abhinandan, VIP Road, Kol - 700052, Bag No. 163, 161, 165 to run the industrial plant and to manufacture/store/install Restaurant with Capital Investment for a period from 31/07/2017 to 31/07/2021 to operate the industrial plant and to discharge liquid effluents through outlets / outfalls and to emit the gaseous emission in accordance with the conditions as mentioned below provided on any day at any instant the quantity and quality of liquid discharge and gaseous emission shall not exceed the permissible limit as specified in the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Breach of the conditions and / or failure to comply with the directions / conditions as stated below shall render the applicant liable for prosecution under the provisions of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

The State Board reserves its right to revoke, withdraw or make any reasonable variation of the conditions of or change or alter this consent by giving one month's notice to the applicant.

Conditions Kh. No. 226, 227, 277, S.L. No. 6, Mouza - Mondal Granthi on land, building, plant & machinery Ri. 28, 08, 800/-

01. The Applicant shall be responsible for the quantity and quality of liquid effluent and gaseous emissions.
02. The Applicant shall maintain the quality of liquid effluent discharge and air emissions and noise levels within statutory limits as mentioned in Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
03. The Applicant shall submit analysis reports of the testing of liquid effluent and air emissions by Board-recognised laboratories with their applications, incase of any, discharge / Emission is involved in the process of manufacture.
04. To bring into any change in industrial plant **This consent will be revoked if there is any violation of E.P. Act 1986 or if any complaint is found valid against the industry regarding environmental pollution.** liquid and gaseous effluents, pollution control equipments the Applicant shall obtain prior permission of the Board in the regard.
05. The Applicant shall maintain good house keeping and working conditions and take all the measures for control of pollution from all sources.
06. The Applicant shall bring about at least 33% of the available open land under green coverage/plantation.
07. The Applicant shall control the fugitive emissions from the activity are so as to maintain clean and safe environment in and around the factory premises.
08. The Applicant shall provide drainage system of conveying liquid wastes.
09. The Applicant shall allow the officers of the Board to enter into the applicant's premises at any reasonable time for inspecting the unit.
10. The Applicant shall make an application to the State Board in the prescribed form for renewal of the consent at least 30 days before the date of expiry of this consent.
11. The solid waste generated within the factory premises, sweepings etc. be disposed off scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution.
12. The Applicant should adopt adequate precautionary measures to prevent any inconvenience or annoyance to the denizens of the locality due to its activity or be a cause for environmental concern.
13. In case of using Diesel Generator, adequate precautionary measures to be taken as per norms fixed up by CPCB.

General Conditions for Orange & Red Category

1. (a) Diesel Generator, if installed, to be provided with acoustic enclosure to keep sound level within permissible limits.
- (b) Diesel Generator to be provided with residential silencer and stack (Chimney) of height 3.5 mtr. (Minimum) above the Generator Room.
- (c) Diesel Engine, if any, to be provided with residential Silencer and stack (Chimney) as above.
2. Domestic (Sanitary) Effluent to be discharged through septic tank to soakpit within the Industry or to Municipal/Panchayat/Industrial Estate drain.
3. Solid Waste (Other than Hazardous Waste) Nil/for sand fill/for reuse/to be sold/to be disposed in Municipal Vat.
4. Ambient noise level will not exceed the permissible limit.
5. Fire licence to be obtained from competent authority for storing and use of flammable items.
6. Permission for Agri Land conversion to be obtained from competent authority (Where applicable).
7. Permission from local body to be obtained before setting up the Unit.
8. Work to be done in closed and covered shed/room for noise reduction.
9. Work period permitted from 8.00 A.M. to 7.00 P.M. (where necessary in residential/congested area).
10. Good house keeping to be maintained.
11. Tree planting - 2 (two) metres width along the periphery of the Industry or sapling in pots (where enough space not available).
12. No construction/activity permitted within CRZ (coastal Regulation Zone) /Area in the District of Midnapore, 24-Farganas (North) and 24-Farganas (South).
13. The Industry shall not undertake any expansion/modification or alteration in the proposed process or equipments without the prior permission of the pollution control authority.
14. This Consent to Establish (NOC) may be revoked immediately at any time if it is found that the industry is not meeting the standards as mentioned by Pollution Control Authority or if the Pollution Control equipments are found to be inoperative.
15. If any complaint is lodged against the Industry regarding environmental Pollution the Consent will be reviewed.
